

## UU COMMUNITY WEEKEND

### FAQ - FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- 1. Who can come?** All members of Unitarian Universalist churches in the greater Philadelphia region are invited to join in this weekend of fun, relaxation and loving community. Individual members, couples, singles, families and friends of all ages are welcome. This is a wonderful multi-generational event that MLUC has held for decades and is now opening to the entire Greater Philly UU Cluster. Come, bring a friend and make new friends.
- 2. What are the cabins like?** Families of 3 or more will probably have their own cabin depending on availability. Most other cabins will be shared with another couple or 2-4 other adults, men/boys, or women/girls depending on which cabin type you sign up for. Cabins have between 10-18 twin-size beds, many more than will be needed. The bathrooms have electrical outlets, sinks, private showers, and toilets with locking doors. Cabins are located close to the lake and within easy walking distance of the dining hall and activities.
- 3. Do the cabins have electrical outlets near the beds?** Yes. There are plenty of outlets for you to recharge your cellphone or plug in your CPAP machine.
- 4. Can we bring bikes?** Bikes are unnecessary and discouraged. Everything is within walking distance.
- 5. Can we go off camp property?** No need to - there is so much to do on camp property. Camp Canadensis is located on 1,000 acres and has over 13 miles of scenic hiking trails, a natural waterfall, a 75-acre private lake as well as lots of camp activities.
- 6. What are meals like?** Meals are provided by Camp Canadensis. All meals are served cafeteria style, with an extensive cereal bar at breakfast, and an extensive salad bar at lunch and dinner. In addition, pasta and nut free peanut butter and jelly sandwiches are always available at lunch and dinner, as well as vegetarian alternatives. Anyone with any special meal restrictions may bring their food and store it in the camp kitchen refrigerator where it will be accessible at mealtimes. Such food should be microwavable.
- 7. Is financial assistance available?** If you need financial assistance, please check with your church administration.
- 8. What if it rains?** The camp has a large covered outdoor pavilion, an art center, indoor hockey rink, and rec room as well as a 100-seat movie theater for rainy days.

**9. What facilities will we have access to for the weekend?** The camp offers lots of facilities for a wide-range of activities for all ages. Here are some of what's available to us during our weekend:

- 75-acre lake for fishing, with canoeing, kayaking, and row boating
- Outdoor heated pool with waterslide
- Climbing Wall
- 13 Miles of hiking trails
- Natural Waterfall Hike
- Tennis courts (bring racquet and balls)
- Gaga courts
- Indoor and outdoor hockey rink (bring skates, helmets, and sticks if interested)
- Soccer fields
- Frisbee Golf course
- Large dining hall
- 100-seat movie theater
- Large auditorium and stage
- Covered outdoor pavilion in the event of rain
- Art center (bring canvases and supplies)
- Outdoor and covered wrestling pavilion, perfect for yoga (bring mats)
- Beach volleyball courts

**10. What is the schedule for the weekend?** Hit the back button and see the weekend schedule link on the main page for this event. There are several activity options during the main activity hours. Participants may choose to join in any of the activities or just relax.

**11. What should we pack?** See the "Packing List" link on the Home Page.

**12. Can adults bring beer or wine?** Yes. Adults of legal age are permitted to bring and *responsibly* consume alcoholic beverages *after hours*.

**13. Is smoking allowed?** Smoking is not allowed.

**14. Can we bring a friend for our child?** Yes. Any minor attending without their parents/guardian must be sponsored by an adult attendee and bring the signed [2017 Canadensis Minor Consent Form](#).

**15. What are the emergency health procedures?** MLUC will have first aid kits at the camp if needed. The camp has an AED in both the Main Office and the Dining Hall. Camp Canadensis Staff would help with true lifesaving support and help call an ambulance if needed. The Pocono Medical Center is 20 minutes away.
